

## Parents' Information- Drama, School Productions and Music

### Drama and School Productions

We try to give all children the opportunity to develop their skills in drama in a variety of ways- through lessons and other opportunities in school.

Reception take part in a Christmas production each year.

There is a Key Stage 1 Christmas service in the Church, which year 2 lead, supported by year 1.

At Key Stage 2, year 4 perform a short play as part of their Christmas service, with others having the opportunity to take part through readings, the choir or a whole school song.

At Harvest year 5 will take the lead, and at Easter the whole school share our activities in the annual 'Easter Pause Day.



In the summer, year 6 lead the end of year leavers' service.

There is an end of year production over 3 nights in the summer. Year 6 take the acting parts - there are auditions for this. Year 5 form a choir to support the production.

There are also class assemblies. Each year there will be one class assembly for each class to which parents are invited.
