Look at the picture carefully It is called 'Andy's Room'.





Then answer these questions Remember to explain why you think whatever your answer is by using 'because' in your sentence.

- Do you know who Andy is? Have you seen him before?
- What are Andy's interests?
- What type of person is Andy?
- How old do you think Andy is?



Example answers (remember yours might be different but still make sense)

- Do you know who Andy is? Have you seen him before?
- I know who Andy is because I have seen him before in Toy Story films. Andy is the boy who owns the toys in this room.
- What are Andy's interests? I know Andy is interested in cowboys because his favourite toy is Woody the cowboy.
- What type of person is Andy? I think Andy is a boy because he likes imaginative toys and it looks like a boy's room.
- How old do you think Andy is? I think Andy is because

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
