Key aims/success criteria

- I know there are no right or wrong answers as long as my ideas fit the picture
- I can answer the questions in a sentence using 'because' to explain



Look at the picture carefully It is called 'Dad'.





Then answer these questions Remember to explain why you think whatever your answer is by using 'because' in your sentence.

- What is the dad doing?
- Why is the girl standing behind him?
- Why is she dragging a kite on the floor?
- Has she said anything to him? Does he know she's there?
- How is she feeling? What is she thinking?
- Do you think this has happened before? Why/why not?

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Example answers (remember yours might be different but still make sense)

- What is the dad doing? The dad is working from home because he is on the computer.
- Why is the girl standing behind him? The girl is standing behind him because she wants something.
- Why is she dragging a kite on the floor? She is dragging the kite on the floor because she wants him to play.
- Has she said anything to him? Does he know she's there? I think she is waiting for an answer to her question because she knows he is doing something important.
- How is she feeling? What is she thinking? I think she is feeling bored and sad because she is on her own.
- Do you think this has happened before? Why/why not? I think it has happened before because she is waiting quite patiently.

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
