Phonics

Read the digraphs you noted down yesterday.

(There is a Phase 5 digraph sound mat in Monday's files if you need it)

Do you remember the sounds of these vowel digraphs and trigraphs from phase 3?

(We practise these a lot but the trigraphs are very hard to remember!)

ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.

As yesterday, note any you don't recall straight away to practise tomorrow.



Today we will read words and sentences with the split digraphs 'e-e' and 'i-e'

even evening delete complete

concrete theme glide bike

slide trifle spike tide

smile mice

There aren't so many words with 'e-e' in them



I glided down the slide at the theme park.

(Look at **glided** - we read **glide** on the first slide but this is in the past tense so adding the 'd' almost hides the split digraph did you spot it?

The tide was high in the evening.

I had trifle for pudding then went for a bike ride.






