


Key aims/success criteria

- You can then read on and find out if your predictions were correct.






Peppa, George, Daddy Pig and Grandpa Pig are watching racing cars on television. "It's such a lovely day, you should go outside and play," Granny Pig says.

Look at the picture and think about what you have just read.

What do you think they might do next?

Remember to start your sentence *I think* and then say *because* to explain your answer.

Daddy Pig paints a big '2' on the car's bonnet.

"Go!" Peppa shouts, waving a
chequered flag.

Remember to start your sentence *I think* and then say *because* to explain your answer.








George is in the lead!

Remember to start your sentence *I think* and then say *because* to explain your answer.








Granny Pig comes outside

Daddy Pig and Grandpa Pig.










What will the end of the story be?
