## Lesson Aims

To apply my knowledge of subtraction to play a game.

## Starter

Write 4 different number sentences where the answer is 5

Can you think of 2 addition and 2 subtraction?

Example: $4+1=5 \quad 6-1=5$

## Activity:

- Today you are going to play a Subtraction board game.
- You will each need a counter/ cube (or any small object at home) and a dice (or you could write the numbers from 1-6 on pieces of paper and turn them face down before choosing one)
- Take turns to throw the dice and solve the subtraction number sentences that you land on (you can use your number line to help)
- If you do not the get the answer correct first time, miss a turn. First one to finish is the winner!
- (Home learners: there are 3 different boards on the pdf. Please try to the second or third one)


## Finally:

Lisa is not sure if she needs to subtract 5 or $\mathbf{6}$ from $\mathbf{2 0}$ to end up with 14.

Can you help her?
