What is he doing?

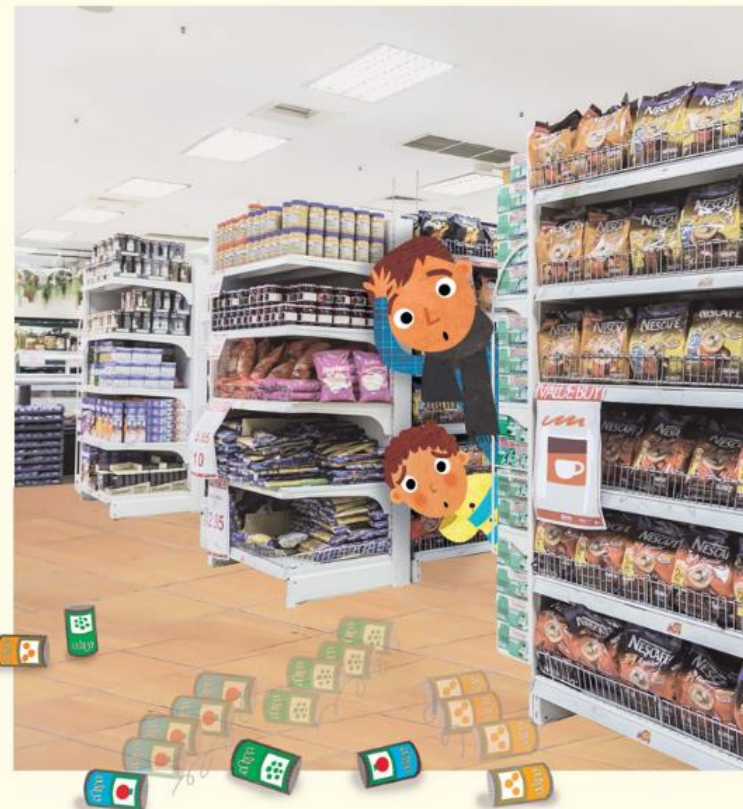
Why does he have that expression on his face?

What do you think will happen at the end of the story?

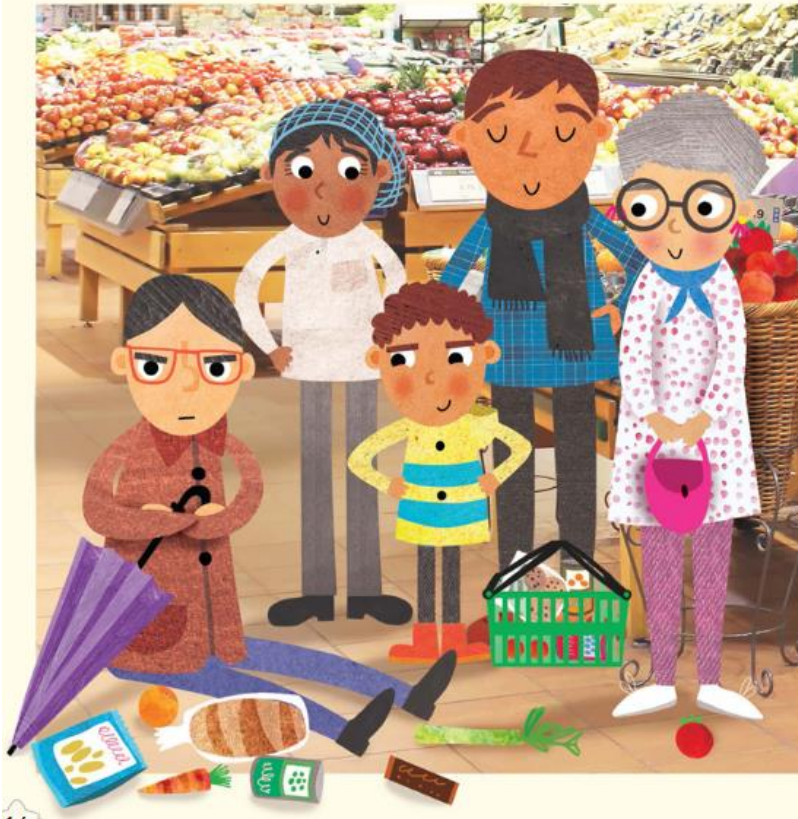
Will the man who got knocked down be ok?
