Place value of numbers, comparing and ordering numbers, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, bonds to 100, understanding related number facts, adding and subtracting numbers within a 10 and crossing 10, adding 3 1-digit numbers, comparing number sentences, solving missing number problems
