This week we have been learning to spell some tricky words using mnemonics — where you take the first letter of each word in a memorable phrase to help you spell a word. For example:

big elephants can't always use small exits for because
cats on umbrellas love ducks for could
sheep on umbrellas love ducks for should
worms on umbrellas love ducks for would

Spread out when you practise your spellings over separate sessions. Don't do them all at once . When you practise, write out each set of words once. Say the word, cover it and then have a go at writing it. If you make a mistake look at where you went wrong, so that you know how to correct your spelling next time. If you need a challenge: Can you write sentences with these words in them?
