This week we have been learning to spell some tricky words using mnemonics – where you take the first letter of each word in a memorable phrase to help you spell a word. For example:

big **e**lephants **c**an't **a**lways **u**se **s**mall **e**xits for because

cats on **u**mbrellas **l**ove **d**ucks for could

sheep on **u**mbrellas **l**ove **d**ucks for should

worms on **u**mbrellas **l**ove **d**ucks for would

Spread out when you practise your spellings over separate sessions. Don't do them all at once 😊. When you practise, write out each set of words once. Say the word, cover it and then have a go at writing it. *If you make a mistake look at where you went wrong, so that you know how to correct your spelling next time.* ***If you need a challenge:*** Can you write sentences with these words in them?
