Theme - Oceans

Hi Year Fivers,

How are you all? We hope you all had a wonderful Easter and remembered that Chocolate is not, in fact, a food group (although it is delicious!). We hope you were able to Skype/Zoom/Teams your friends and families and catch up with them all. We also hope that you have been able to get outside into the Spring sunshine a little and enjoy seeing nature waking up after its Winter sleep.

Things at School are carrying on - there are some children at School every day and we will be trying to follow the same theme as they are for our topic work from this week forward. Our Theme this week is going to be Oceans and we have tried to include some great Ocean activities to keep you busy.

You may have had a bit of a rest over the past couple of weeks as, in normal times, these weeks would have been the Easter break. Now we are back into term time, try to keep to the work Schedule below (or your version of it) if you can. However, there will be some days when this is easy and some when it just will not work as your family have other things going on or you are working on other projects. Don't worry! Try to do a bit of reading every day, a bit of times tables practice and a bit of Doodle Maths and if you can manage to work through some of the suggestions below when you have time (or access to the computer!) then that would be fantastic.

Doodle Maths - please log onto Doodle Maths and spend some time practising before you complete your Maths activity for the day. We are receiving lots of feedback on Doodle Maths from parents and children saying they are loving it, so if you have not yet logged on, do that this week! Try to do a couple of the 7aDay tasks - they're a bit like the arithmetic starter you get in a normal Maths lesson.

Purple Mash - Don't forget to post any work or comments to Purple Mash if you can - we would love to see what you have been up to!

Suggested Tasks for this week:

English - This week we would like you to have a go at writing an Ocean themed Shape Poem. Have a look at the pages on the website and work through the steps.

Session 1 - Carefully read through the first 6 pages of the Ocean Shape Poem slides.

Session 2 - Work through slides 7, 8 and 9. Write up your ideas in your Home Working Book (remember the date and title - Ocean Shape Poem).

Session 3/4 - Write your own Ocean Shape Poem (there are some great shape template ideas on the Website). When you have finished, you could decorate your page with an Ocean theme.

Guided Reading - Purple Mash - the next two Chapters of the Guided Reading text are available in the 2Dos section - choose whether you want to do the Circles/Triangles or Triangles/Squares text. Read each chapter and then answer the Quiz. Or, if you cannot access Purple Mash or you want to do an Oceans themed non-fiction text, there is a Guided Reading text on the Website.

Maths - Keep up your daily practice of 5 a day <https://corbettmathsprimary.com/5-a-day/> and challenge yourself to Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum!

Remember to practise your times tables - TTRockstars, writing them out, playing times tables games or any other way that works for you. Don't forget the TTRockstars battle - Lime vs Cedar. The current one finishes on Saturday and Cedar are miles ahead at the moment! Come on Lime! A new battle will start on Sunday and run for two weeks - Good Luck!

Log into Doodle Maths and do a couple of the 7aDay tasks (a bit like our Fluent in Five!). Set work will be in your 'Extras' area. (You need to complete this first before your 7aDay tasks.). There are also a few Maths tasks on Purple Mash for you to try.

We are going to continue to focus on 2D **shape** this week. Work through the slides on shape on the Website and then have a go at the tasks. There is also a challenge if you manage to finish everything.

RE - We have posted some RE learning for you to look at. The tasks are explained on the document which has been uploaded to the Year 5 Home Learning pages.

Topic - There will be some 'Whole School' topic work posted to the website this week around our theme of Oceans. Have a look at the tasks and have a go!

Art - This week there are a couple of great Ocean art projects for you to have a go at. Check the website for details.
