



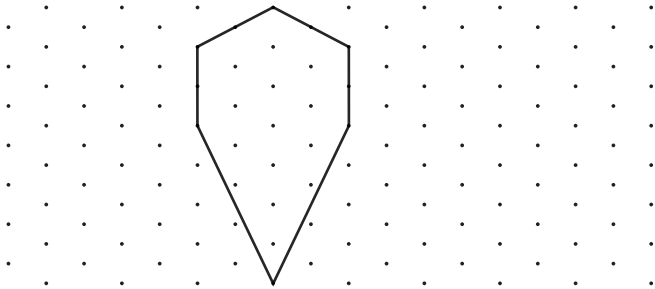

b) A rhombus must have four sides of the same length. As a result, a square is a type of rhombus and is therefore an example of a regular rhombus.

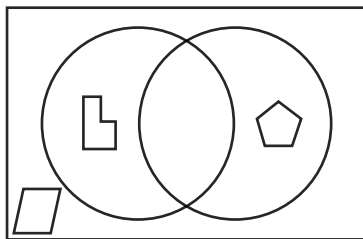
