## Main Teaching

What do we need to remember when we measure with a ruler?

When we measure with a ruler we must make sure we put the ruler in the correct place.

The ' O ' or the first mark on the ruler must be placed at the beginning of the line or object.

5 cm


It is the same when we draw a line with a ruler.

We must start drawing our line at the ' 0 ' and finish drawing it when we get to the correct number.
