What Does Sequencing Suki Do?

Sequencing Suki helps with:

Identify and explain the **sequence** of events in texts.

This means that she is there to help you to think about the **order** things happen in.

She might ask you to put different events from the text into the order they happened. She may ask you what happened first or last. She could ask you to match events to the day or time they happened.

What Might Sequencing Suki Ask?

Sequencing Suki might ask questions like these:

Who do we meet first in this story?

What is the last step of these instructions?

Put these sentences into the order they happened in.

Use 20 words to sum up what happened in this story.

Draw a picture to show what happened in the middle of the story.

Do I need to read this text in the order it is written?

What happens if you don't?
