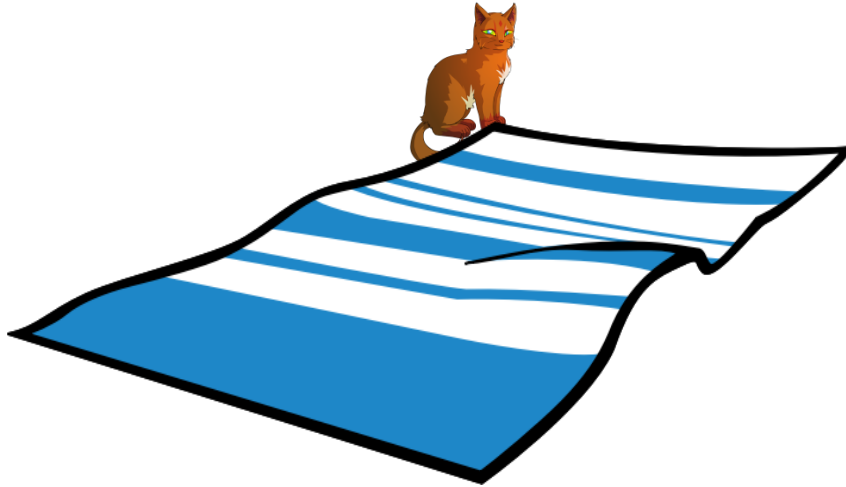

Statements

- A sentence that tells us something and gives us information.
- It ends with a full stop.

It is raining in London today.



Commands

- A command is a sentence that tells someone what to do.e.g:

Please wash up.

Go and tidy your room.

Stronger commands are those which need to be followed immediately.e.g,

Stop!

Run away from the fire!

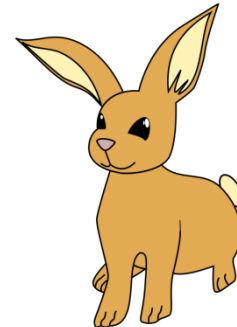
