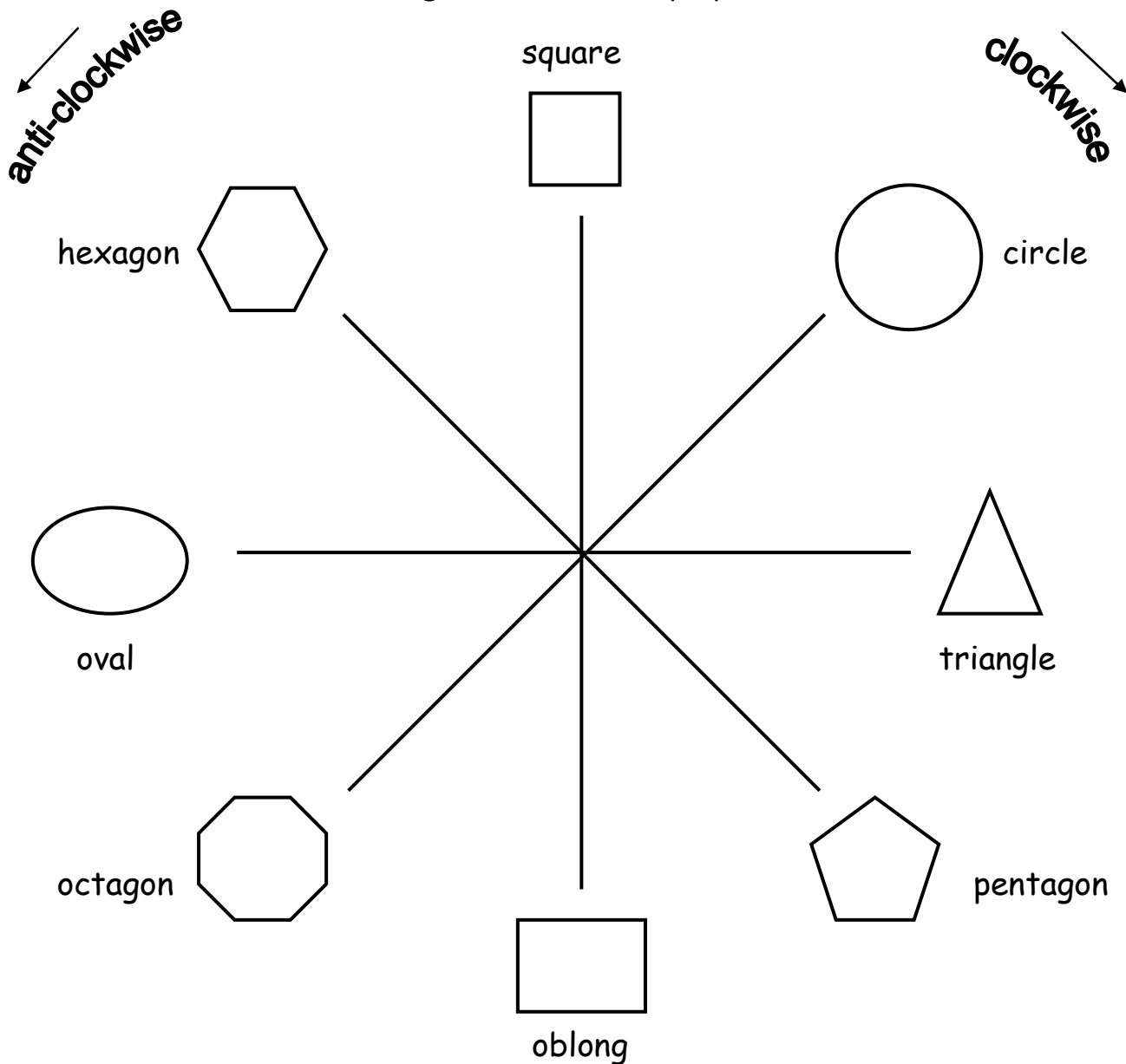


# Angles of Turn

(A game for 2 to 4 players)



## You will need

- This playing board
- A set of Instruction cards (cut up)
- Counters or cubes

## How to play

- Shuffle the Instruction cards and place them face down on the table.
- Players take in turns to take a card and read the instructions out loud. They imagine they are standing in the centre of the 2D shapes, facing the square and then follow the instructions given. They say out loud what shape they are now facing.
- The other players check to see if they are right. If they are right, they can take a counter. Then the next player takes their turn.
- When all the cards have been followed, the winner is the player with the most counters.

Face the triangle and half turn clockwise	Face the hexagon and quarter turn anti-clockwise	Face the square and whole turn clockwise
Face the pentagon and 3 quarters turn clockwise	Face the octagon and half turn anti-clockwise	Face the oval and quarter turn clockwise
Face the circle and whole turn anti-clockwise	Face the oblong and 3 quarters turn anti-clockwise	Face the square and half turn clockwise
Face the circle and quarter turn anti-clockwise	Face the triangle and whole turn clockwise	Face the oblong and 3 quarters turn clockwise
Face the pentagon and half turn anti-clockwise	Face the octagon and quarter turn clockwise	Face the oval and whole turn anti-clockwise
Face the hexagon and 3 quarters turn anti-clockwise	Face the oval and half turn anti-clockwise	Face the circle and half turn clockwise
