Plan for Topic

We are beginning a new topic in RE, all about Judaism.

Through this topic, we are going to be looking at:

- how Jews mark stages in life through special ceremonies such as Bar / Bat Mitzvah and weddings.
- that <u>Pesach</u> (Passover) recalls the events of the Exodus and is celebrated each year with the Seder meal.
- that <u>Sukkot</u> is a Jewish harvest festival and recalls God's provision in the desert.
- that Rosh Hashanah celebrates Jewish New Year.
- that Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) is a time for repentance and forgiveness.
