SPaG Starter – Answers

Behind the door, there was a secret tunnel.
(preposition)

As she dashed home, she stumbled over a root,
tripped and fell onto her knees. (conjunction)

Yesterday, I had to go to the dentist. (adverb)

As brave as a lion, he fought the enemy. (simile)




Lesson Aims

Success Criteria – for whole myth

- **Use this success criteria to help you.**
- I can use noun phrases (*dark, black cloak*)
- I can use a sentence of 3 (*Loki had a golden cloak, long, black boots and a strong helmet*)  **extend this with a conjunction**
- I can use adverbs
- I can use conjunctions to extend the sentence
- I can start sentences in different ways – (*conjunctions, prepositions, similes, adverbs*)
- **I can start the sentence with a subordinate clause**
- **I can use a simile**
- **I can use a drop in clause**
