- Timmy **was has been** in his spaceship for twenty years.



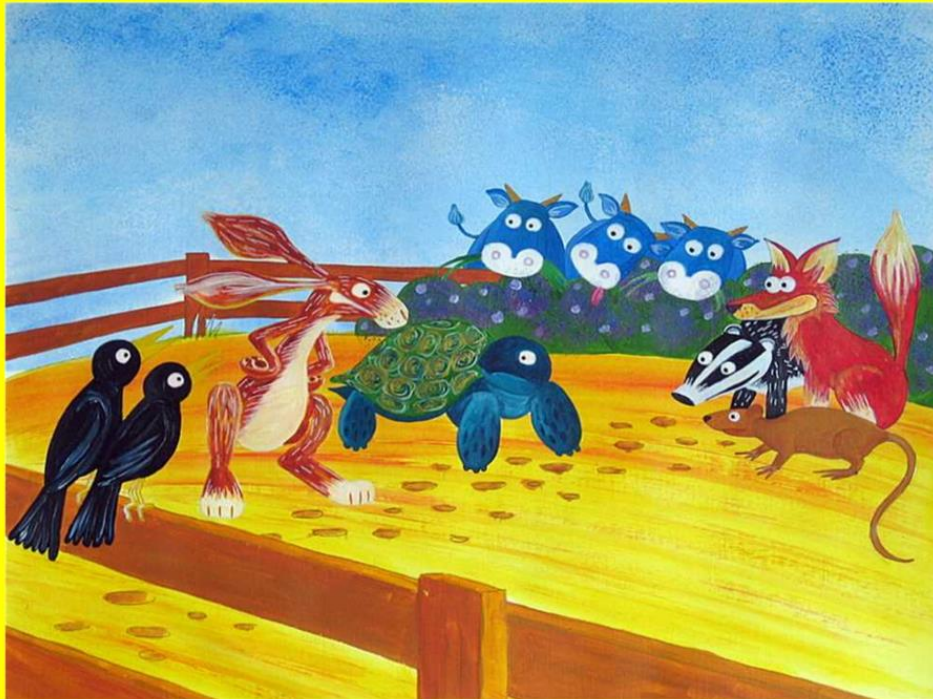
