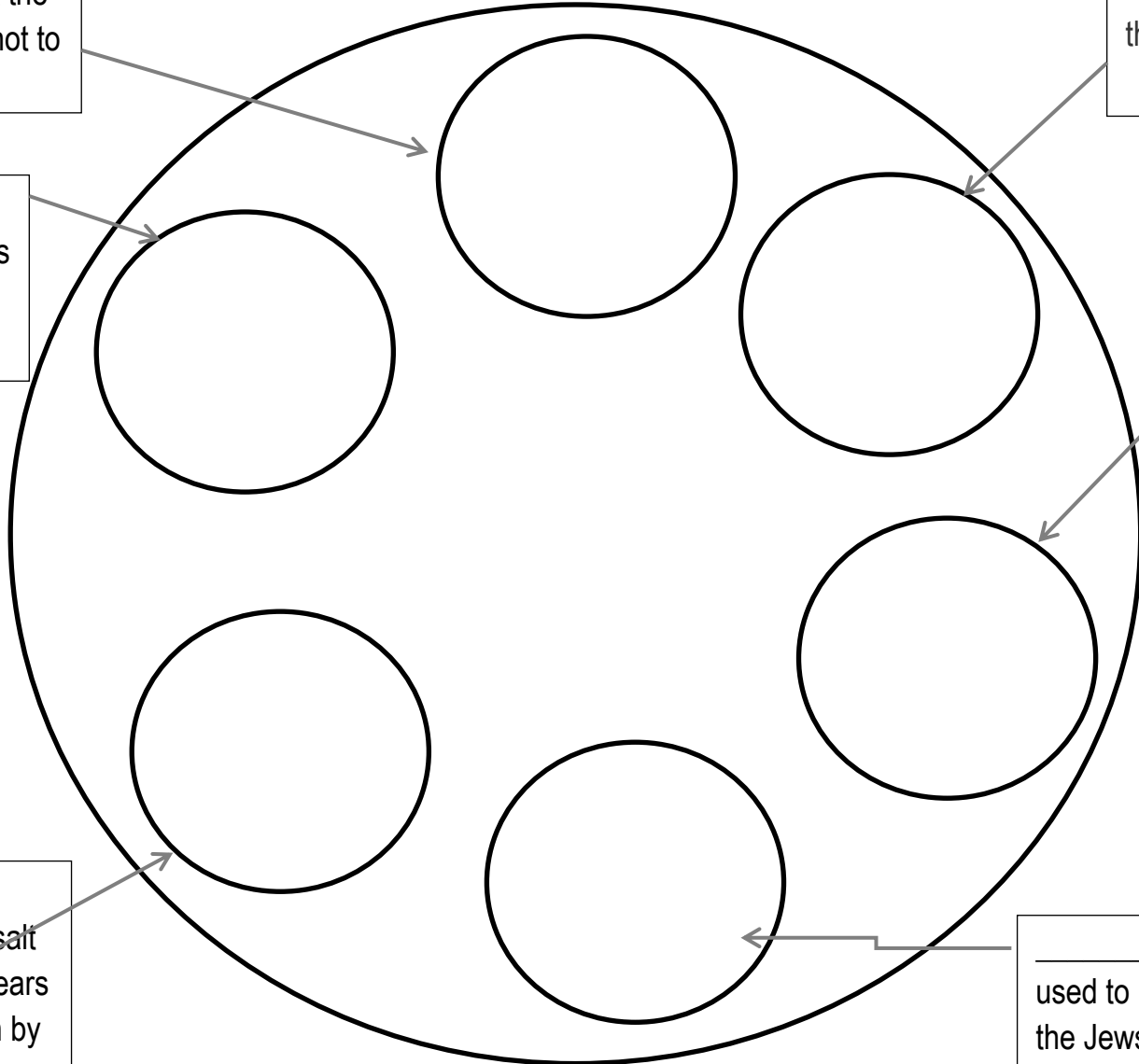


I know when and why the Jews celebrate Passover.
