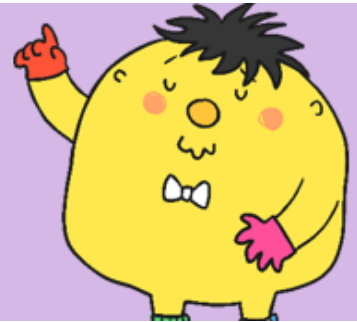

# Success Criteria

LO: To write a non - chronological report on a Dragon

SC: I can write a main title - underlined

I can use subheadings - underlined

I can use conjunctions - *but, if, so, because, as, when which*

I can use a sentence of 3 extended with a conjunction ( *useful in appearance section* )

I can use adjectives

I can use determiners - *some, most, a few, all*

I can use adverbs

I can use a simile - *its wings were as red as blood*





# Example

- Habitat from plan
- Habitat
- Usually live in damp, dark caves on sides of mountains
- A few hide in grey thunder clouds
- They like cold, wet weather
- Will never be seen in hot, dry deserts.

## Habitat expanded using success criteria

Usually storm dragons live in damp, dark caves which can be found on the sides of mountains. If they don't like the dark a few will hide in grey thunder clouds where they can see more easily. All storm dragons like cold, wet weather because that is what they create. You will never see one in hot, dry deserts. That would be their worst nightmare!
