MATHS - Today we are adding and subtracting a unit number from a 3 digit number. Look at the ppt and see if you can answer the questions as you work through it. Once you have done this there is a worksheet for you to complete.

ENGLISH - We are still using the story of Where the Wild Things Are. Today we are going to be thinking about a new area of grammar called The Fronted Adverbial. This is just an adverb which goes at the beginning of the sentence.

We can have them for

How something happens - suddenly, quietly, quickly

Where something happens - in the distance, next to his bed

When something happens - yesterday, at 3 o'clock

They must always have a comma after the adverbial -

Suddenly, a tropical forest grew in Max's room.

Work through the ppt and then complete the worksheet.

GEOGRAPHY - we are thinking about food miles today and how far the food that we have on our plate has to travel.

Look at the ppt about making a pizza and think about how far the ingredients that go on that pizza have had to travel.

Then use the worksheets to plot where different foods have come from.

Can you think of a way to reduce food miles. What could you do?
