can not → can't

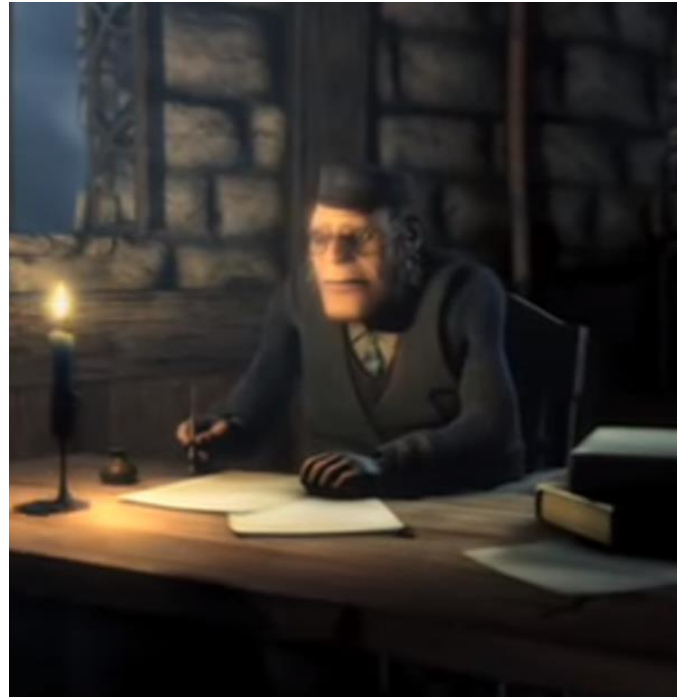
