

Wednesday timetable and lessons

Hello!

We have another fun day of learning planned for you. We appreciate it might be a little tricky to be learning at home, so do what you can. Time on Doodlemaths and TT Rockstars all helps.

MATHS – Today you are writing the number sentences before solving the word problems tomorrow. Use your knowledge of expanded addition and expanded subtraction. The word problems are on the last page of the power point. Parents and carers, there is a sheet called maths methods if your child needs a reminder.

ENGLISH – We are continuing to looking at the short film ‘The Lighthouse’. We will be studying this film during this week and next.

First though, we are learning about contractions. Contracted words are where two short words have been put together and been made into one word. The letters that are taken away are replaced with an apostrophe. For example, can not becomes can’t, I will becomes I’ll and he will becomes he’ll. Yesterday you wrote or told your parent and carers about the story using fronted adverbials and conjunctions. Watch the video to remind yourself of what happens.
