**MATHS** – Today is a fluency lesson for times tables. We are practising those that you are working on at home and learning and playing a dice game.

PSHE – This week has been anti bullying week. We would like you take a look at the powerpoint and discuss the picture.
Think about these questions
What can you see in the picture
How do you think the children in the picture are feeling?
Why do you think the boy is being left out?
Do you think this might have happened before?
What age do you think they are?
When people bully other people there are quite often a few people involved
The target – this is the person at whom the bullying is aimed
The assistant – this is the person who is actually doing the bullying
The reinforcer – these people support the bully, they might laugh or encourage other people to join in with what is going on.
The outsider – these people ignore the bullying and don't want to get involved.

Think about these two questions

Do you agree that we should all stand against bullying? What changes do we need to make to unite against bullying? What can we do as a school to stop bullying?
