His nose,

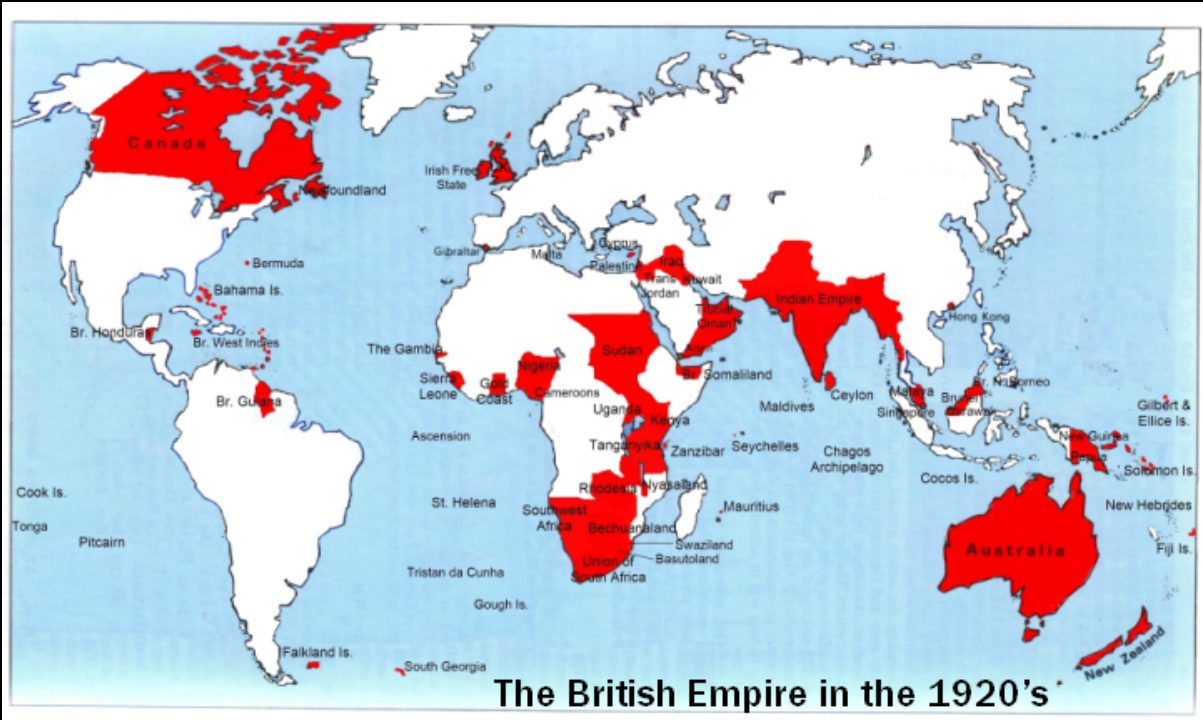
