We hope you had a fantastic weekend and managed to get outside! This week, we are moving on in English to look at prepositions and continuing our work on fractions in Maths. We also have RE, History, Science, French and PSHE. We hope you enjoy it all.

MATHS – This week we are looking at fractions, in particular how to work out fractions of a set of objects. Some of this work you will have covered in Year 2 but it is important to understand what a fraction is a part of a whole.

Don't forget there is also Doodle Maths that we have set and TT Rock Stars to practise your x tables.

ENGLISH – We are looking at prepositions. These are words such as above, behind and next to that tell you where something is positioned. Follow the PowerPoint, then have a go at writing sentences about the animals in the jungle. There is a word bank to help you. RE – We are learning about the story of Jonah and the whale and how God saved him when he was inside the whale's tummy. Use the PowerPoint and watch this video to find out more.
