Picasso – Dove of Peace

The Dove is a bird long associated with the theme of peace.

There was also a strong connection between artist Picasso and this beautiful species, and in several different ways. Not only did they feature in his life in several places that he lived, but they also symbolised much of what he believed in, politically.

The original title of this simple sketch was simply - La Colombe, or, The Dove. It developed a strong following after being drawn in January 1949.





Picasso - Dove of Peace

Dove of Peace, 1949 by Pablo **Picasso**.

Picasso's first Dove of Peace, chosen as the emblem for the First International **Peace**

Conference in Paris in 1949, was a traditional, realistic picture of a pigeon which had been given to him by his great friend and rival, the French artist Henri Matisse.



The Dove of Peace became a popular symbol for campaigners of peace, liberation and equality all around the world
