LO:

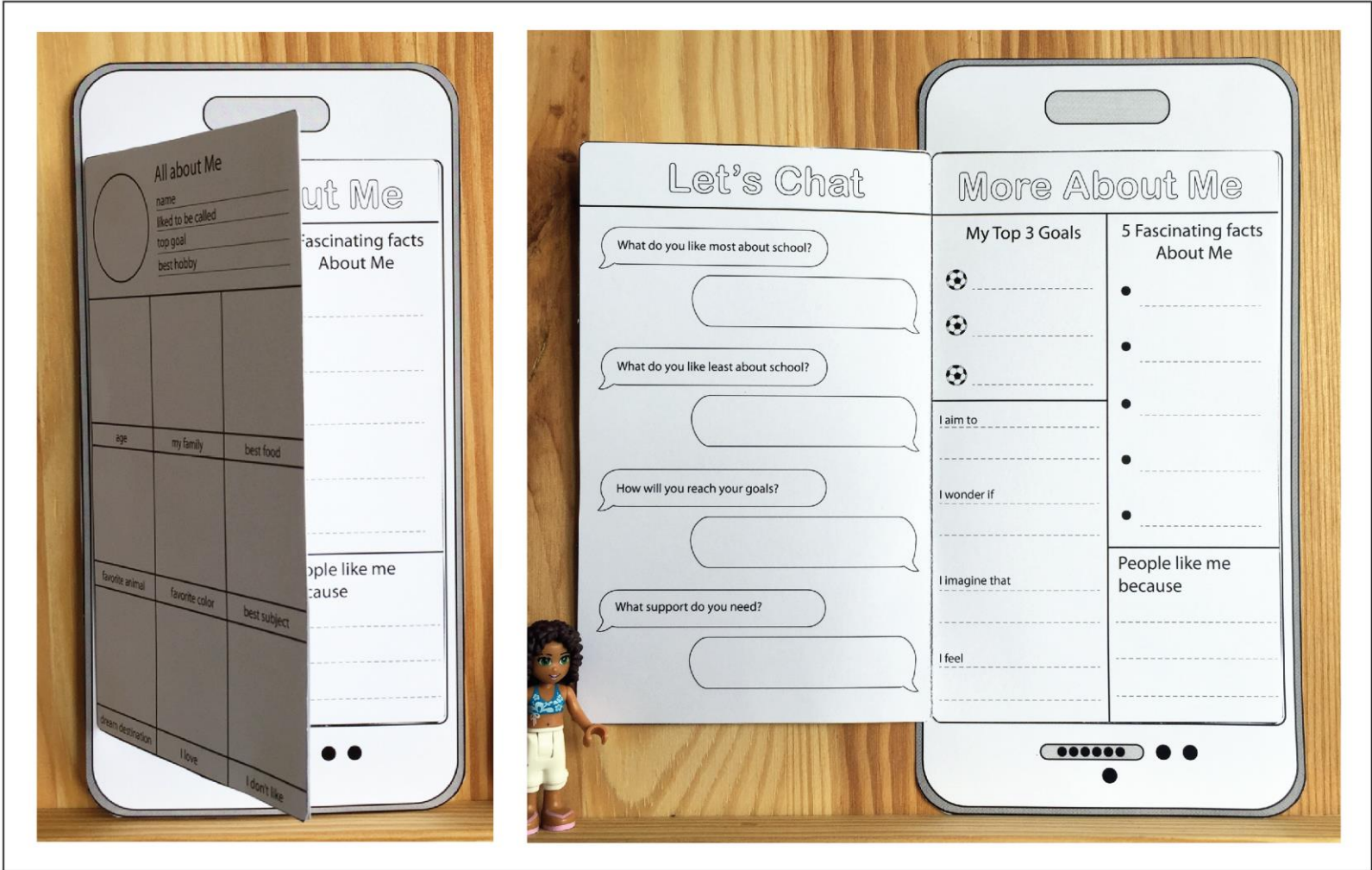
Print from the resource document or copy and make the design for the phone. Choose the size that you wish to use. There is a small size template (uk spelling) template, which works well (page 12,13).
