

Playing rules

- ♦ Ensure all players start with the same amount of money (£200 is recommended).
- ♦ Take turns to roll the dice and move your counter the appropriate amount of spaces.
- ♦ All Reading, Grammar and Spelling spaces can be purchased for £30 each.
- ♦ Place a counter or marker to show which spaces you own. These should be of different colours.
- ♦ Reading, Grammar and Spelling spaces all require a question to be answered.
- ♦ For Spelling questions, another person must read the card aloud. One word should be read, not both.
Top word = 3/4 list. Bottom word = 5/6 list.
- ♦ If someone else owns the space you land on and you answer the question correctly, you do not owe this person anything. Incorrectly = £20 payment.
- ♦ Correctly answering a homophone check card is rewarded with £10 from the bank. Incorrect answers result in a £10 payment to the bank.
 - ♦ Early release from jail costs £30.
- ♦ The winner could be the last player left with any money, or the person with the most money / property after 5 or 10 turns for each player.
