- Detailed and informative
- Well organised with paragraphs



Main Teaching

Activity

 - **who are your friends and what did you enjoy doing together (in and out of school!) e.g. going to Costa**
 - what will you miss?

- Feelings about the future: what are you looking forward to at secondary school; **do you have any ambitions? e.g. to be a vet, doctor, work with animals etc.**
