4) $\frac{5}{8}$ of 24 =

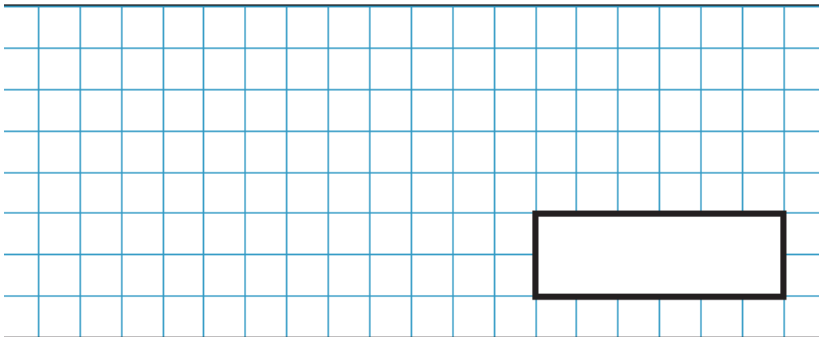
There are 24 pieces of fruit in a bowl.
