This art will be scanned and made into a yearbook along with some writing, which you will complete in the next couple of weeks.

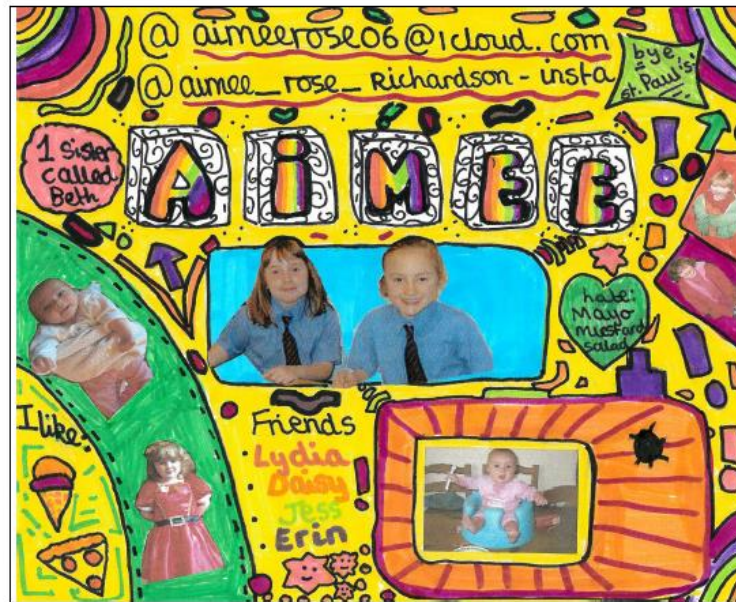
