Supporting your children at home Homework

Homework will be sent home on a Friday and should be returned on the Wednesday following.

Homework will start on the end of September.

Maths - the children will be set a small maths activity each week that will reflect the work they have done in school the week before.

Phonics / Spellings - the children will also receive a short phonics / spellings task that will be based on the sounds or spellings they practiced in class the week before.

Please only spend a maximum of <u>20 minutes on homework</u> and if they do not complete the task in that time, then that is ok.

Supporting your children at home

Homework

Topic - there will be a topic homework set each half term. The children will get a few weeks to complete this before needing to return it.

The first topic homework will be sent out in Autumn 2.



Reading - 3 times a week

Reading is <u>really</u> important as it develops their comprehension skills, expands their vocabulary knowledge, develops imagination and can help strengthen their writing skills.

Books - linked to their phonics phase, will be given out on Thursdays and <u>must</u> be returned by Mondays.

Reading record - log every home read. Return these, along with their reading book, every day.

If your child is sent home with a book they have read before, please don't worry. They should still read it to build fluency.

Sharing books - Please return shared books as soon as they are finished to swap for new titles.
