Adverbials of Number

Can you order these instructions and use adverbials of number to add cohesion?

Ice-Cream Cone Craft

Crumple tissue paper to fill the cone up to the top and glue this in.

Roll the brown paper into a cone shape and glue together.

Gather all the equipment needed, including paper, glue, cotton wool, beads, scissors and pens.

Draw diagonal lines on the brown paper so that it looks like an ice-cream cone.

Drizzle PVA glue over the cotton wool so that you can stick beads on to look like sprinkles.

Drizzle PVA glue over the tissue paper before sticking cotton wool to look like vanilla ice-cream.

Adverbials of Number Answers

Can you order these instructions and use adverbials of number to add cohesion?

Ice-Cream Cone Craft

Firstly, gather all the equipment needed, including paper, glue, cotton wool, beads, scissors and pens.

Secondly, draw diagonal lines on the brown paper so that it looks like an ice-cream cone.

Thirdly, roll the brown paper into a cone shape and glue together.

Next, crumple tissue paper to fill the cone up to the top and glue this in.

Then, drizzle PVA glue over the tissue paper before sticking cotton wool to look like vanilla ice-cream.

Finally, drizzle PVA glue over the cotton wool so that you can stick beads on to look like sprinkles.

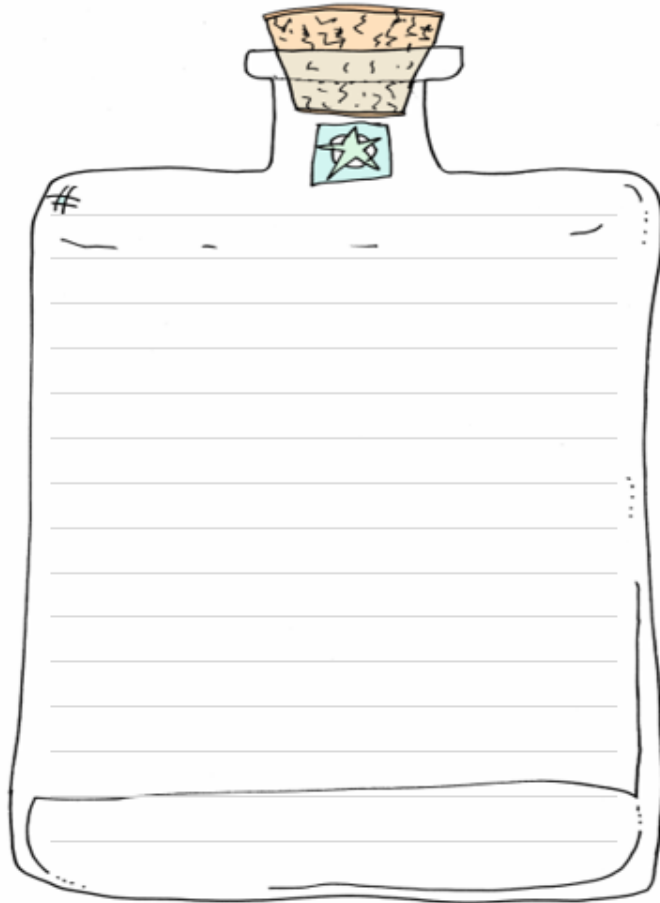
Proof-read, edit, improve and Publish
