


Plan for Week – Guided Reading

Year 1 Guided Reading [8th June 2020] Memories



Key aims/success criteria

- I can look for clues in the picture to help me understand.
- I can use the clues to answer questions....
- I know there are no right or wrong answers as long as my ideas fit the picture
- I can answer the questions in a sentence using 'because' to explain



Look at the picture carefully It is called 'Memories'.





Then answer these questions Remember to explain why you think whatever your answer is by using 'because' in your sentence.

- Where do you think this is?
- When is this? (What time of year/day?)
- What is the woman doing?
- Who carved the heart into the tree? Why did they do it? Why this tree?
- Why is this picture called 'Memories'? What is she remembering?
- How does she feel?



Example answers

- Where do you think this is? I think this is in the woods because...(there are lots of trees).....
- When is this? (What time of year/day?) *I think it is winter because ...(there is snow on the ground)....*
- What is the woman doing? The woman is tracing the heart on the tree because...(she put it there/ she does this when she walks past it every time/ she is remembering who did it)..
- Who carved the heart into the tree? I think (*boyfriend/naughty person/husband/she*).... carved the heart because...(*they were sad/in love/missed her/ missed someone/were lonely*)..
- Why this tree? I think it is a special tree because (that is where they met/they planted it/they climbed it).
- Why is this picture called 'Memories'? What is she remembering? I think it is called memories because she is remembering happy times/ a long time ago/ an old friend.
- How does she feel? I think she feels sad because her face looks sad.
