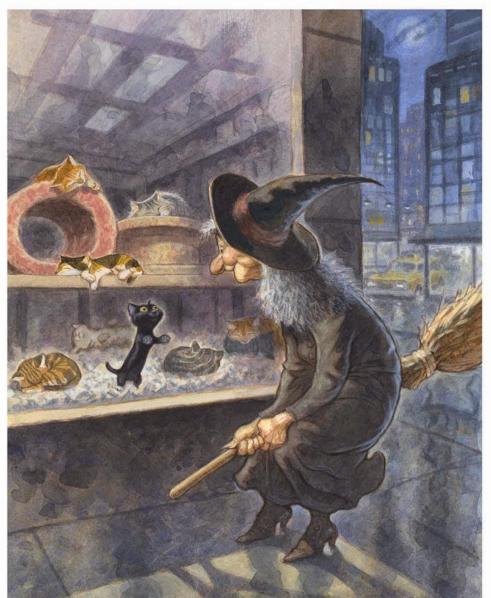


Key aims/success criteria

Look at the picture carefully It is called 'Something familiar'.





Then answer these questions Remember to explain why you think whatever your answer is by using 'because' in your sentence.

- Why is the black cat the only cat looking at the witch?
- Why did the witch come here? Was she just passing or did she come to the shop for a reason?
- What is the 'something familiar'? Why?
- Do the witch and the cat already know each other?



Example answers (remember yours might be different but still make sense)

- Why is the black cat the only cat looking at the witch? The black cat is the only one looking at the witch because witches always have black cats in stories.
- Why did the witch come here? Was she just passing or did she come to the shop for a reason? The witch came to the shop because she wants a new cat.
- What is the 'something familiar'? Why? I think the something familiar is a black cat because witches look for black cats.
- Do the witch and the cat already know each other? I think maybe the witch already has the mummy cat because the kitten in the window knows the witch
- Or
- I think black cats just know to look out for witches because witches like black cats.
