A crooked old wizard with a beard of frost entered the room. A shiver ran through George as the room became icy cold.


"Only one more to find," the wizard cackled.

Draw the beginning (George flying on his dragon)


Next (George finding the castle)


Then (George finding/hiding in the egg room)
