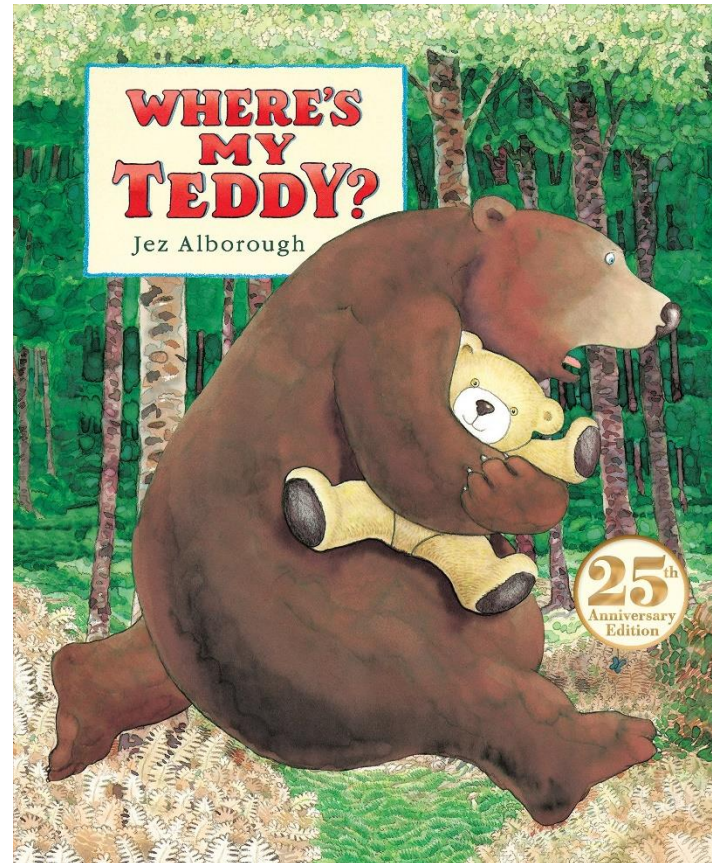


Where's My Teddy?

Day 1:

In the story of ‘**Where’s My Teddy**’, most of the story takes place in the woods. We call this the **setting**. The **setting** in a story is where the action takes place. Some stories have more than one setting.



Aims for today: To go into the copse and use our senses to explore what is around us.

- Recap: Can you name all 5 of our senses?
- Sight
- Hearing
- Touch
- Smell
- Taste
- Which do you think we be using today?



We will go in to the copse and use our sense of **touch, hearing** and **sight** .

We will need to be very still for the first 5 minutes so that we can really listen and look around us before we go and have a walk around the copse to see what other things we notice and can touch.

REMEMBER: There are things that can harm us if we put them in our mouth so we must **NOT** put anything near our face and we need to be careful of the brambles and stinging nettles!
