I can form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place

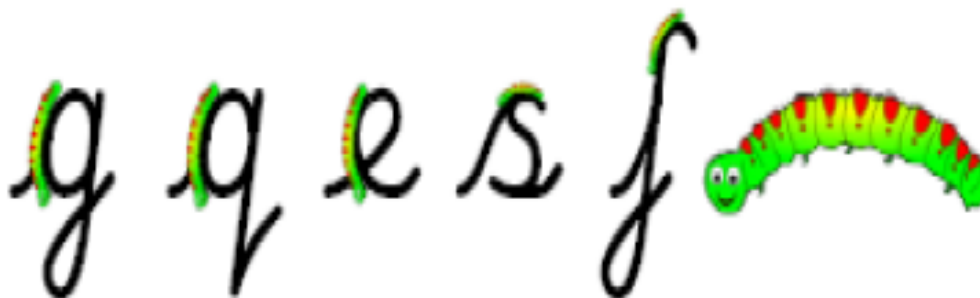
I understand which letters belong to which handwriting 'families' (i.e. letters that are formed in similar ways) and to practise these

Can you write each letter on an adults back using your magic finger? Can they guess what the letter is? If they write it on your back, can you name the letter?

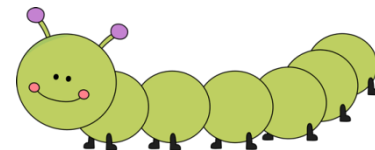


Practise time
