

How did Jesus change lives?


Does he still change lives today?

- Some people might admire Steve Backshall, Lionel Messi or David Walliams. Why?




Some might admire someone like Steve Backshall or David Attenborough.

Feedback...




Would any of these people let themselves become unpopular?


Why do people admire or worship Jesus?

Steve is passionate about animals and wildlife. He knows a lot about his area of interest and he knows how to entertain people by doing quite a lot of risky encounters with animals and reptiles. He will go quite far to interact with these animals – risk his life too! So far he has not done anything to become unpopular for what he believes in.



Jesus is passionate about God, His people, His animals and everything in the world. He wants people to know about his passions and he risked his life to do that too. He died for what he believed in and he became unpopular with many for what he believed in too.
