


## Key aims/success criteria

- Do you think this story is set a long time ago or from today? Why? How can you tell?




#### **Discuss**

## The Railway Children

- The story is called 'The Railway Children'
- The author is Edith Nesbit and was written in 1906.
- It was also made into a film in 1970.

The story is about a family with 3 children, Roberta, Peter and Phyllis who move from London to a new house in the country near a railway. The children enjoy watching the trains and waving to the passengers. One day there is a landslide on the track and the children make flags with red material to warn the driver to stop so he doesn't crash into the landslide. Roberta (the oldest girl) decides to stand on the rails so that the train driver can see her and will definitely stop in time.
