ENGLISH – We are continuing to looking at the short film 'The Lighthouse'. We will be studying this film during this week and next. Watch the video to remind yourself of what happens.

To begin with, we are learning about contractions. Contracted words are where two short words have been put together and been made into one word. The letters that are taken away are replaced with an apostrophe. For example, can not becomes can't, I will becomes I'll and he will becomes he'll.
