We also have RE, History, Science, PSHE and as it is anti – bullying week this week there is also some work on that. We hope you enjoy it all.

MATHS – This week we are looking at fractions. Some of this work you will have covered in Year 2 but it is important to understand what a fraction is – a part of a whole. You will be exploring fractions today and seeing how many different ways you can sort some fraction cards. Can you give mathematical reasons for the ways that you have sorted them?

Don't forget there is also Doodle Maths that we have set and TT RocksStars to practise your x tables.

ENGLISH – You will be looking at two pieces of non – chronological work on Tigers and Elephants. You will need to work out what the main features of both are. You can highlight these on the texts. Once you have done this there is a non – chronological report on Unicorns, which is all muddled up, for you to cut up and stick on the planning sheet in the correct order. RE – We are learning about the story of Daniel and how he was saved by God when he was thrown into the Lion's den. Use the ppt and watch this video to find out more.
