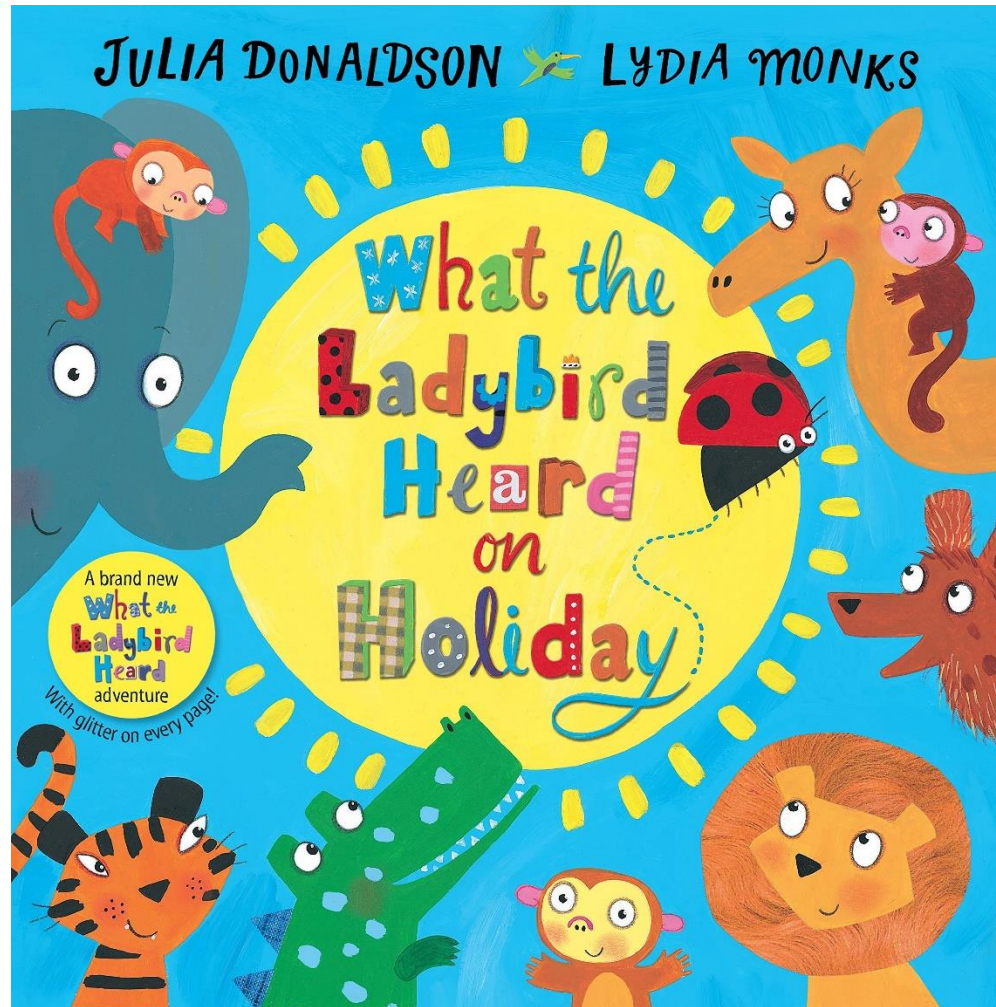


## Key aims/success criteria
