Lesson Aims

To apply my knowledge of telling the time to half an hour to play a game.



Starter



- Play a game of 'ping pong' where the adult 'bats' a month of the year or day of the week to you.
- You have to 'bat' back the month or day that you comes next.
- Swap over roles.



Activity:

- Quick recap: What have we learnt this week about telling the time to the half hour (o'clock and half past)?
- Can you remember the position of the long and short hands when it is an o'clock or half past time?
- Today you are going to play a game of 'o'clock' bingo in class.
- Listen while your teacher explains the rules.
- You can also play the 'half past and o'clock 'board game as a class. The teacher can place the board under the visualiser and roll the dice, and you can help to read the times. (Home learners, you have the choice of both games so decide which one you would like to play.) Have fun!
