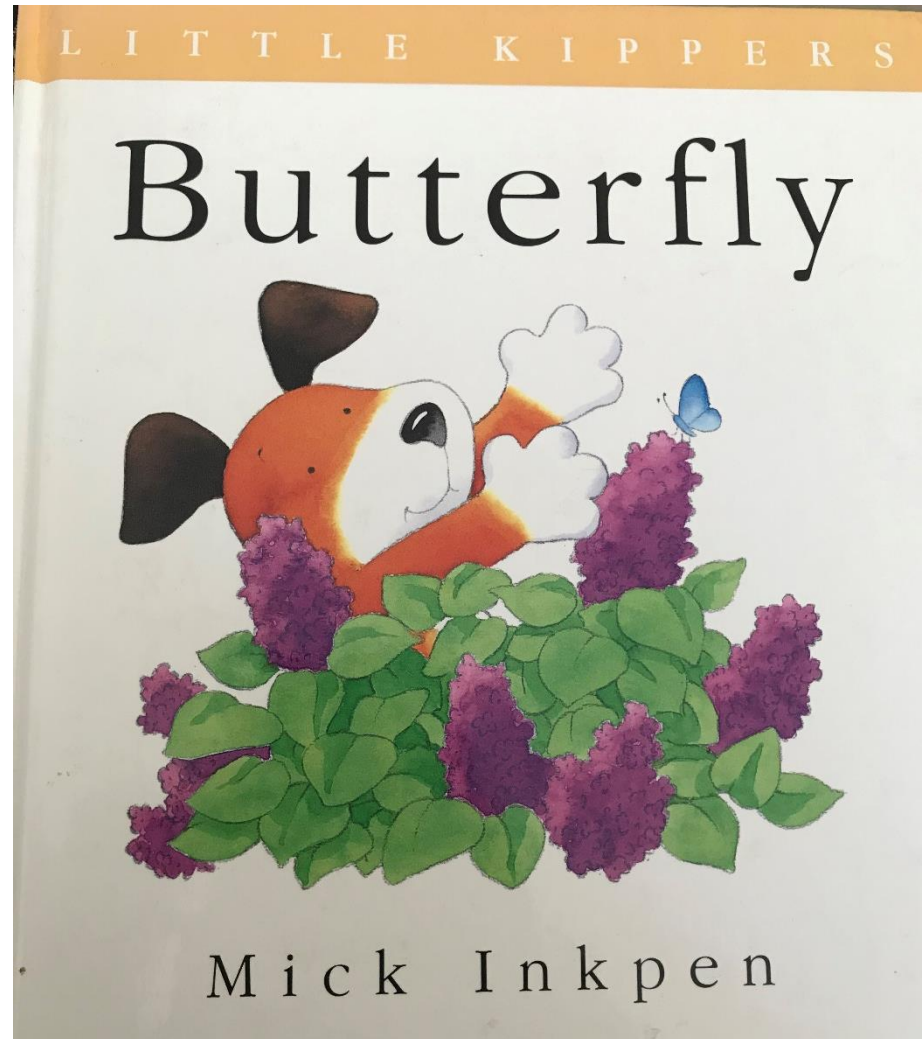


Key aims/success criteria

A little blue one.

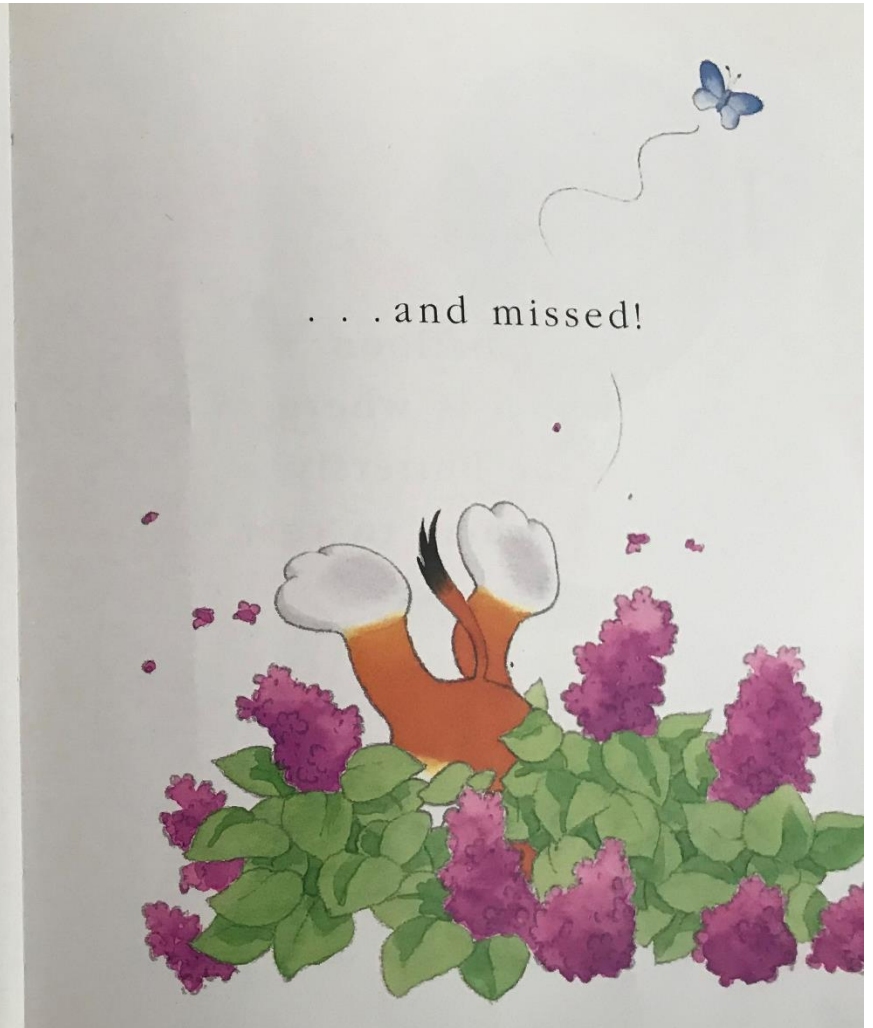
It landed on Pig's lolly.

said Pig.



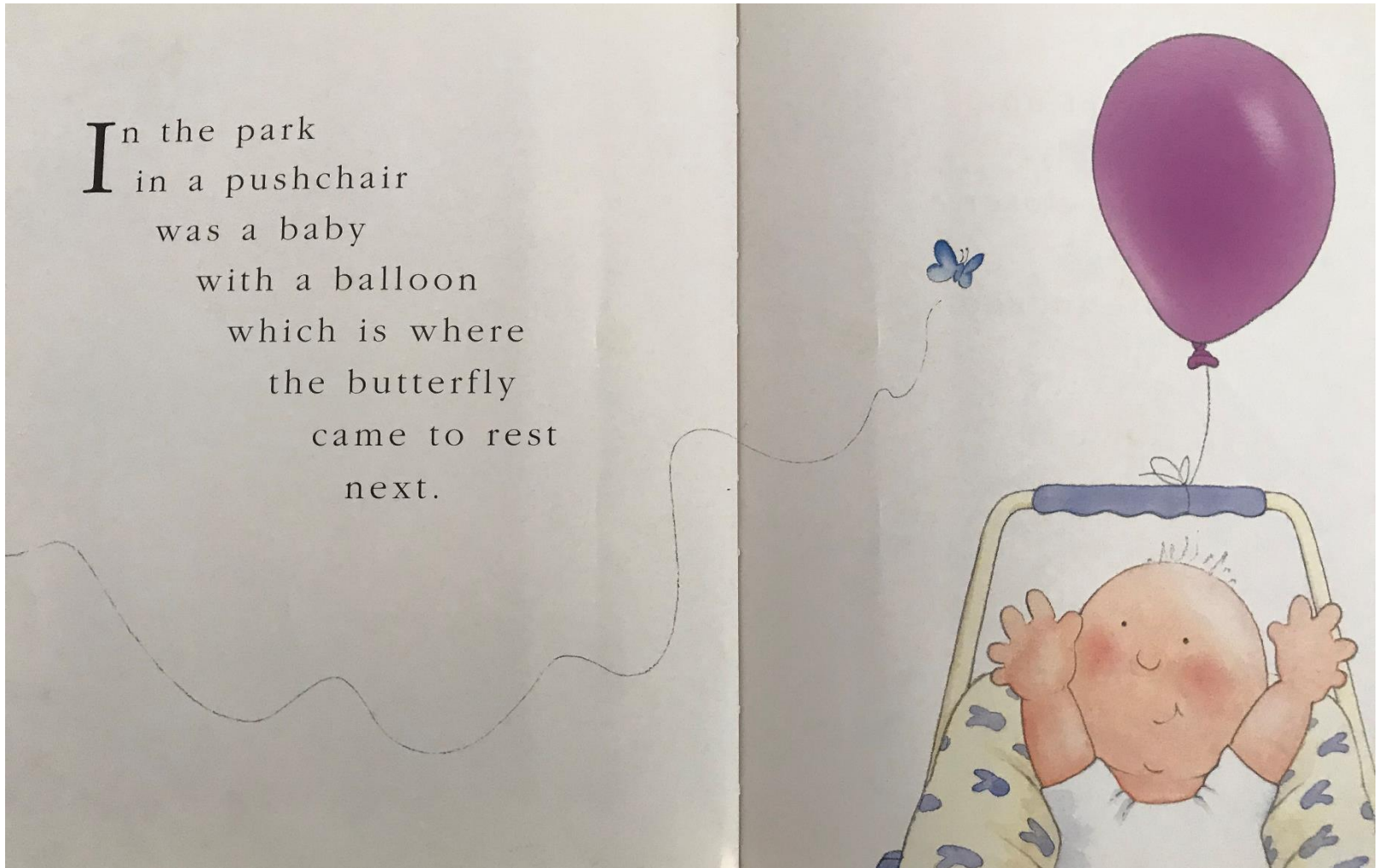


The butterfly flew to

the balloon burst!

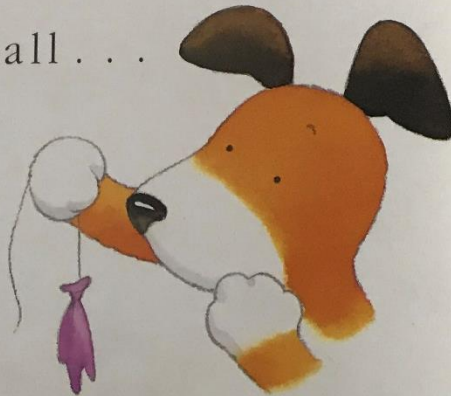




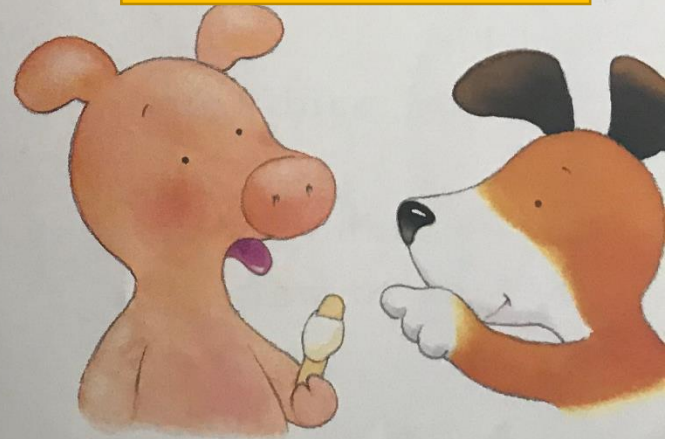
Kipper looked at the

said Pig.

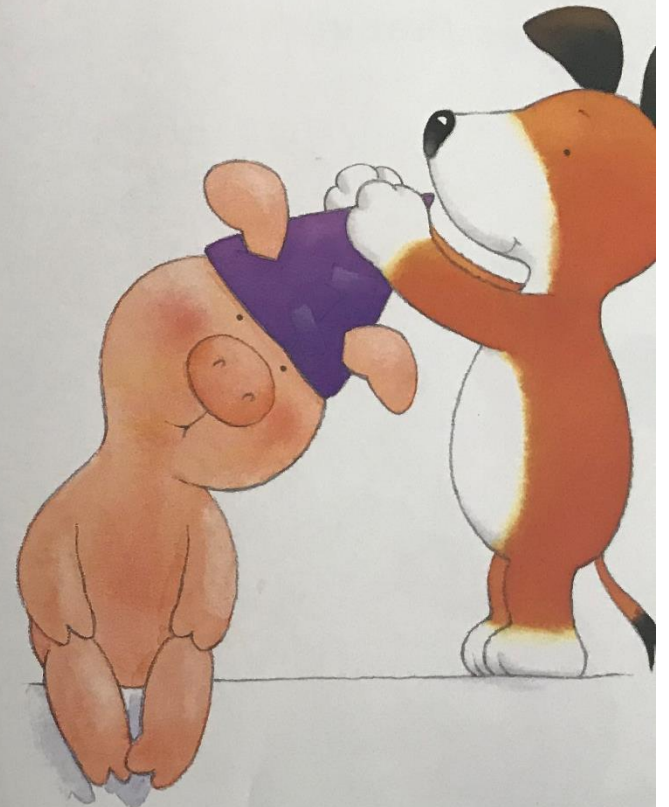
‘Shhh!’ said Kipper.

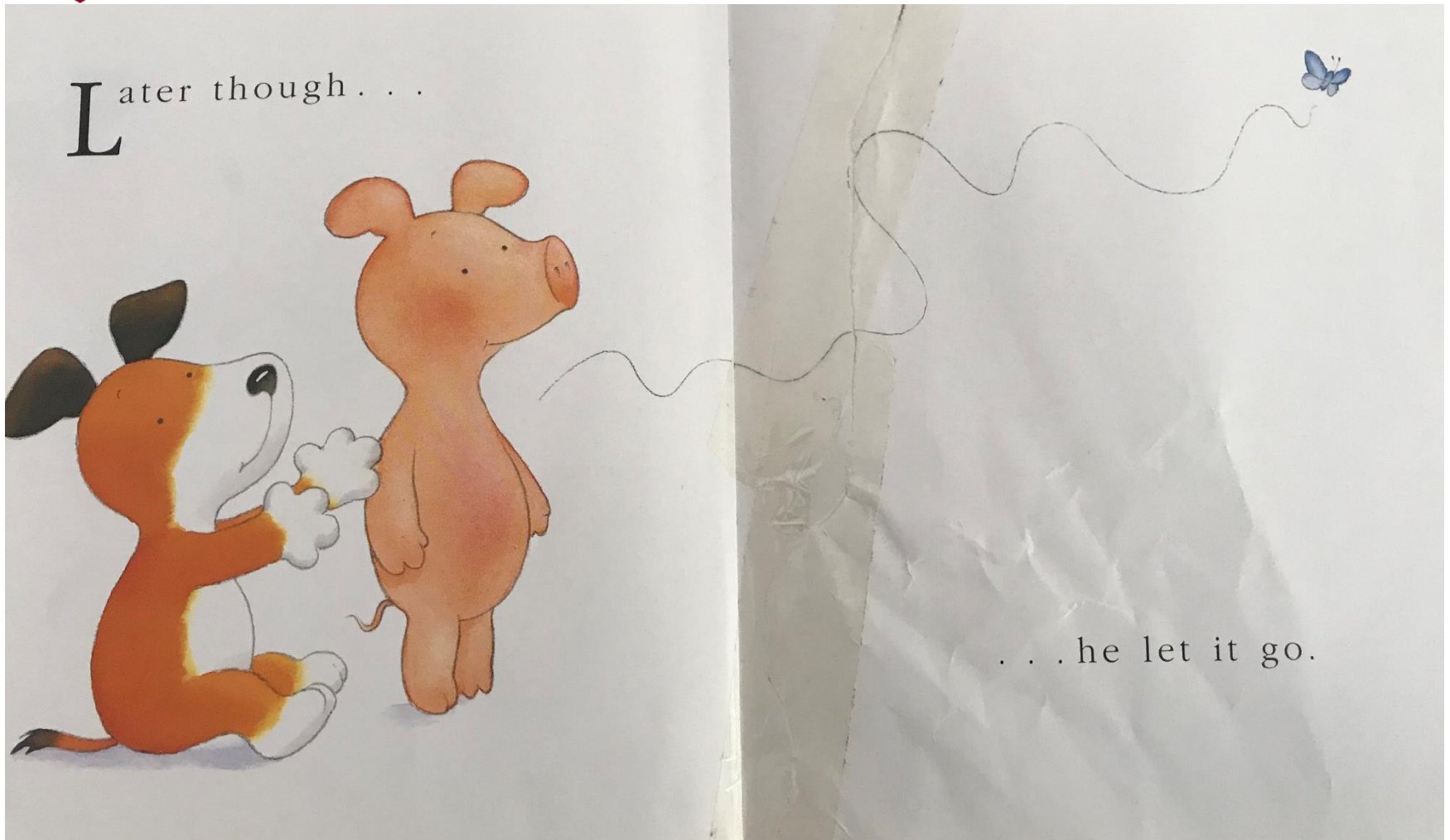
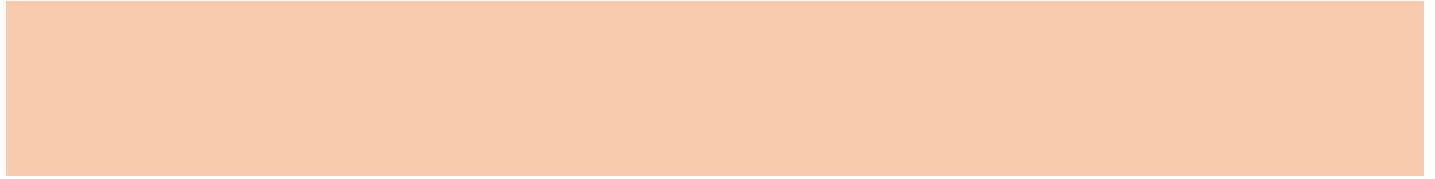
They didn’t have
