


Key aims/success criteria

Read this book together.






Activity

See if you can predict what that word is by using the clues from what you just read, picture clues and what you will read after the missing word.











The butterfly flew to the top of a lilac bush.

That was when the balloon burst!






Kipper looked at the balloon. He went back to the lilac bush and looked at the blossom.

'Show me your tongue!'










Kipper made a pointed, purple, paper hat.

He put it on Pig. 'What's this for?' said Pig. 'Shhh!' said Kipper.


They didn't have long to wait.
