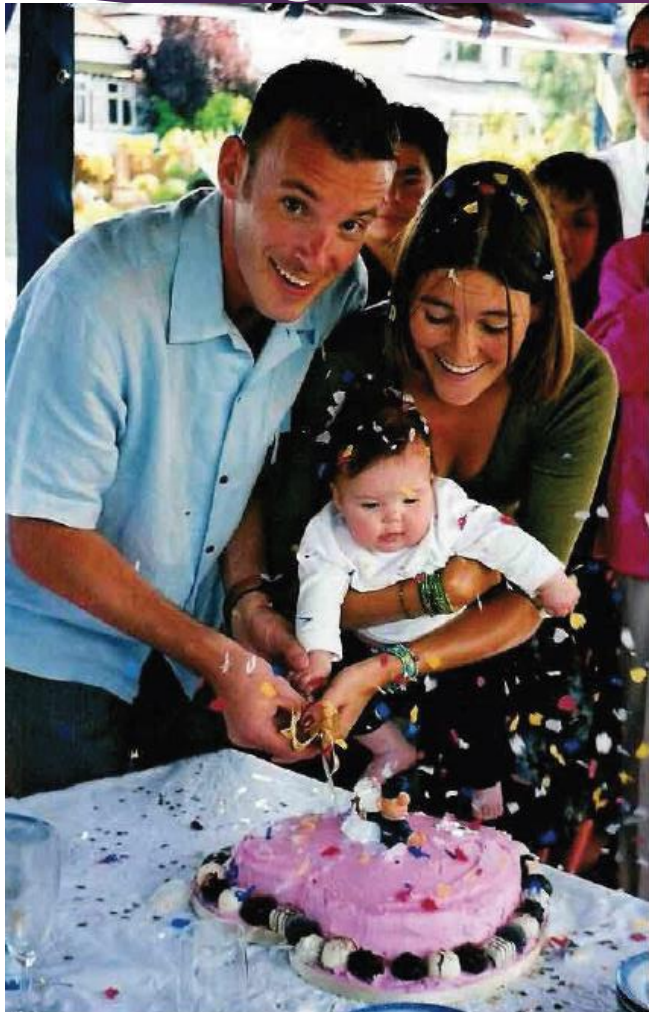

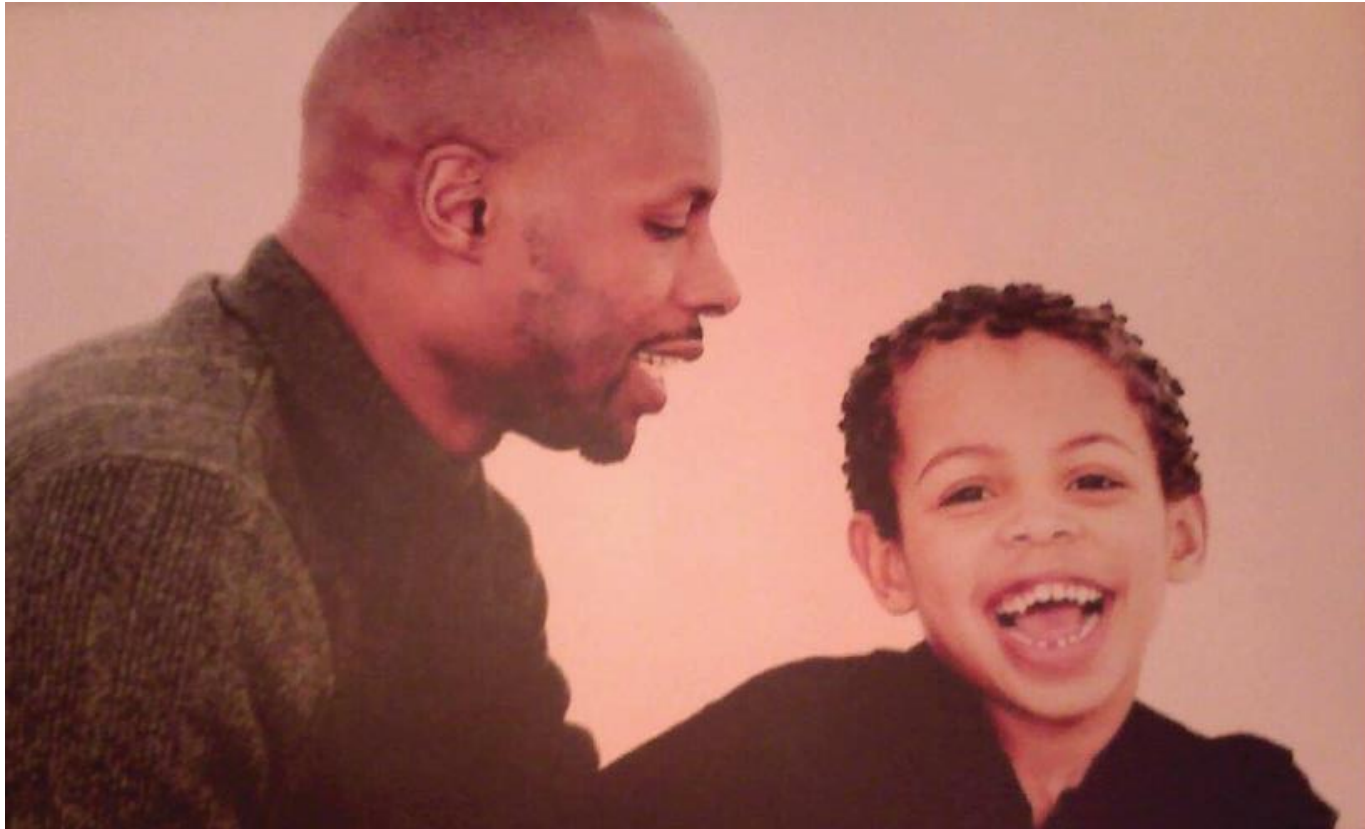
Families

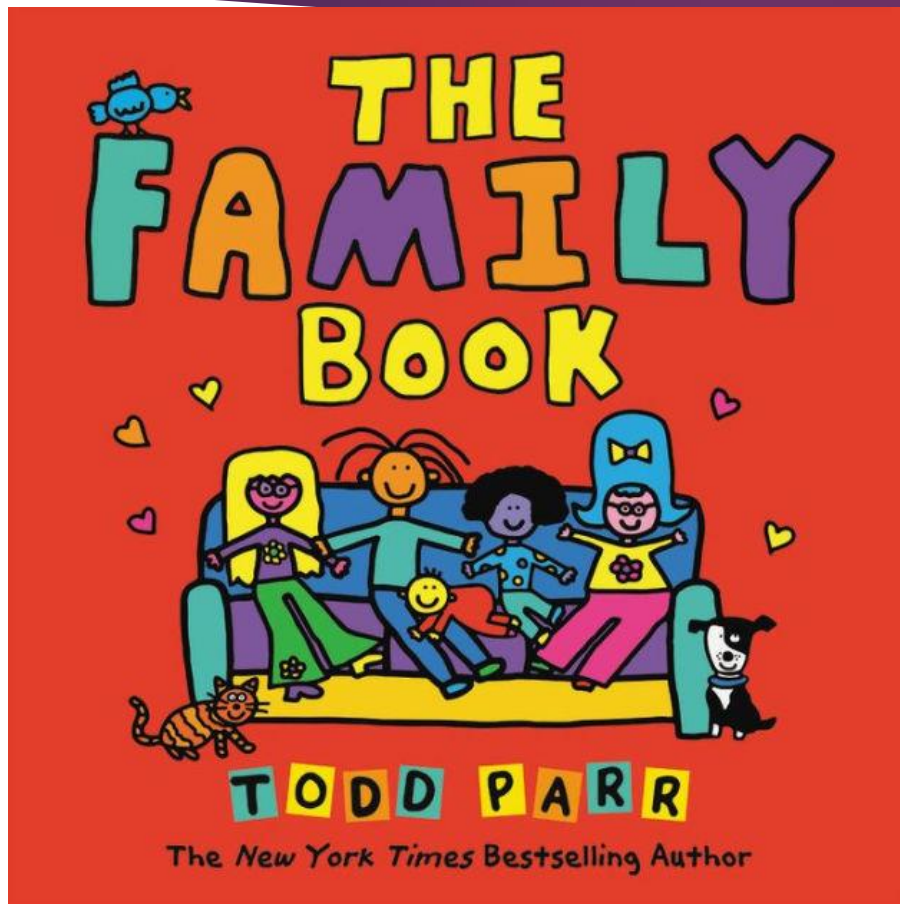
