Lesson Aims

- a apron

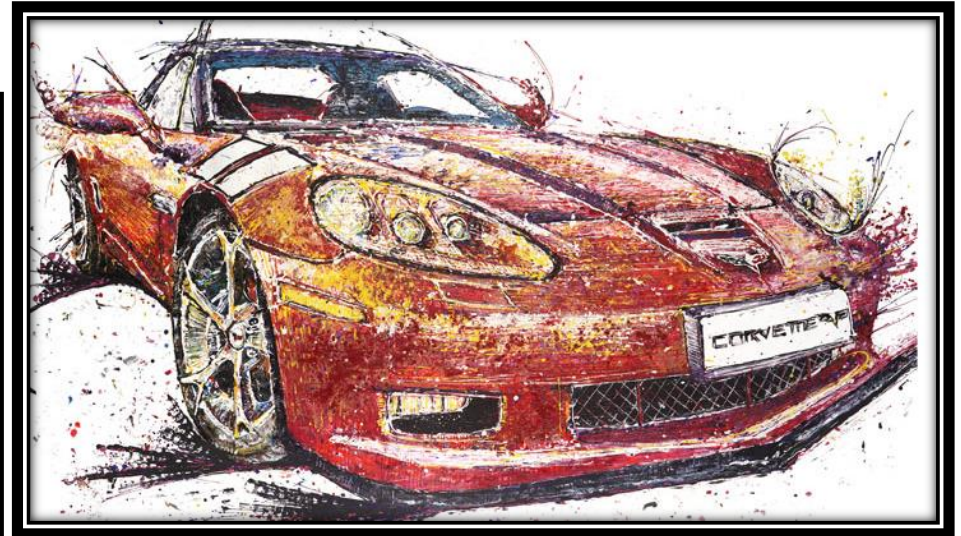


He uses remote control cars and wheels.
